



Sustainable Supply Chain Policy

While realizing our sustainable growth strategy, Akcoat aims to cooperate with its stakeholders in the supply chain on sustainability management and its components, to increase sustainability awareness, and to support its activities with exemplary environmentally sensitive approaches.

The Sustainable Supply Chain Policy and **Supply Chain Code of Conduct** are designed to ensure that Suppliers' business practices are in line with Akcoat values and existing legal rules, and full compliance is expected by all Suppliers.

Suppliers should prepare these rules for their suppliers and establish principles for their implementation.

Akcoat's supply chain professionals hold the globally recognized and accepted CIPS (Chartered Institute of Procurement & Supply) certification. CIPS is an internationally renowned organization in the field of procurement and supply chain management, providing certifications that ensure professionals adopt best practices and achieve excellence in procurement processes.

In Akcoat Supplier audits, the compliance of its suppliers with these rules is questioned, corrective action is opened for nonconformities, and improvement is expected.

Improvements made are also checked through follow-up audits.

Akcoat may request the suspension of any supplier employee who acts in violation of the applicable legal legislation or in a manner contradictory to these business principles and/or may terminate the contract with the relevant supplier. The method to be followed by the supplier for suspicious behavior contrary to ethical principles and rule violation incidents is described in Akkök Supply Chain Business Ethics Principles. Akkök Holding Ethics Committee and ethics hotline are the communication mechanisms through which our stakeholders can submit their complaints.
